To Parents and Guardians of Grade 12 Students:

As the end of the school year approaches, we are beginning to make preparations for our graduation activities. The Commencement Ceremony and the Grad Banquet, as well as the Strawberry Tea, are scheduled to take place on June 1st and 2nd respectively. In order to participate in these activities, grade 12 students must be in a position to graduate. We have been communicating the following information to students throughout the year and again at the most recent Grad meeting held on April 13th:

- ☉ Students must have completed or have a reasonable expectation of completing 80 credits (48 credits for required courses, 28 elective credits, and 4 credits for Graduation Transitions). Sixteen (16) of these credits must be at the grade 12 level.
- ☉ Any courses in progress outside of Aldergrove Community Secondary (online courses etc ...) must be 75% complete with a passing grade as of May 10th. It is the student's responsibility to obtain a progress report which indicates that 75% of the course is complete, with a passing grade.
- ☉ Any courses needed for graduation that are in progress at Aldergrove Community Secondary must be in good standing as of May 12th at the latest.
- ☉ Graduation Transitions 12 should have been completed by the end of 1st semester (January 30th).

Throughout the week of April 24th, staff will be determining which students are on the grad list and which students are not currently meeting the criteria to be on the grad list. Staff will meet with students who are not on the grad list and outline what they need to do to put themselves in a position to be on the grad list and consequently attend the grad events. Parents will also be notified if their son or daughter is NOT on the grad list.

It is important to note that students who are not on the grad list at the end of this week will have an opportunity to reinstate their graduation status. Students who are not on the grad list will have until Friday, May 12th to be in a position to graduate and to participate in the graduation activities as outlined above.
